

SHOWER ARM AND FLANGE INSTALLATION

Refer to the <u>Parts Breakdown Book</u> for replacement part numbers or <u>contact customer support</u> for help in finding a part

You may need several of these tools:

Allen wrench (5/16 or 7/32)

- » Channel locks
- » Crescent wrench

Flathead screwdriver

Phillips head screwdriver

Pipe joint compound

- » Soft cloth
- » Teflon tape

No tools necessary

NOTE: YOU MUST HAVE ACCESS TO THE BACK OF THE WALL IN ORDER TO REPLACE YOUR SHOWER ARM

- 1. Behind the wall, unscrew nut using crescent wrench, and remove metal crimp washer.
- From the tub side, remove the entire assembly from wall.
- Unscrew showerhead where it connects at the shower arm.
- 4. Install new flange and shower arm. Replace showerhead. Teflon tape can be used on shower arm threads before reattaching showerhead.
- 5. Tighten if necessary using channel locks. Wrap showerhead with soft cloth to protect finish.
