## You may need several of these tools:

Allen wrench (5/16 or 7/32)

- » Channel locks
  - Crescent wrench
  - Flathead screwdriver
  - Phillips head screwdriver
  - Pipe joint compound
- » Soft cloth
- Teflon tape
  No tools necessary
- 1. Unscrew old showerhead where it connects at the shower arm. There is no need to remove flange.
- 2. Wrap shower arm threads with teflon tape (optional).
- 3. Screw new showerhead onto shower arm. Tighten if necessary using channel locks. Wrap end of showerhead with soft cloth to protect finish.
- 4. Turn on water, check for leaks.
